3 Day Tour – “Discover Central Flinders” (WT03AC)

Highlights:

Departs Adelaide on demand - this tour allows us to explore the fascinating Central Flinders region around Wilpena Pound – and also included the amazing Mt Chambers gorge with an easy walk to an ancient rock engraving site.

Pick up at 7.30am from Adelaide CBD

Itinerary:

Included: Morning tea, lunches, 4WD tour and nature walks, dinner (2 course), bed & breakfast (continental or cooked) Twin/share accommodation.

Day one: 7.30 am. pickup from your hotel in Adelaide, and travel 300 Kms North to Pichi Richi Pass and the historic Ghan Railway township of Quorn for lunch, visit the spectacular Warren Gorge & the Kanyaka Homestead Ruins abandoned during the Great Drought of 1864-7 convenience stop at Hawker the Hub of the Flinders Ranges and the gateway to the Outback before travelling through the Moralana Scenic Drive, one of the best in the Flinders Ranges, continuing on to the Pugilist Hill Lookout for views of the Chace Range & Wilpena Pound. Check into accommodation at Wilpena Pound Resort.

Day two: Depart for Mount Chambers Gorge, the most spectacular accessible gorge in the Flinders Ranges. 4WD trek into the gorge for morning tea in idyllic river Red Gum surroundings and walk along the floor of Mt Chambers Creek to view the gallery of aboriginal rock engravings reputed to be thousands of years old. Visit the old copper mining town of Blinman for lunch and return to Wilpena Pound Resort via Parachilna Gorge, Bunyeroo Valley / Gorge & Brachina Gorge within the Ikara-Flinders Ranges National Park, a geological journey through 640 million years.

Day three: Early breakfast before easy walk into the spectacular, ancient geological formation called Wilpena Pound. Then return to Adelaide Lunch at Hawker or Orroroo before continuing on through the quality wine producing Clare Valley. Short stop in Clare, then arrive in Adelaide approx 6.00 – 6.30pm.

Minimum 2 persons Maximum 4 persons / vehicle (We will take 6 persons - only as one group i.e. Three couples or a family.) 4 only when passengers come from different locations.
